Tips For Calling 911

- No matter what, stay calm.
- Be prepared to give your name, phone number, address or location.
- Let the dispatcher guide the conversation.
- Wait for the dispatcher to ask the questions.
- Listen carefully and follow directions.
- Be prepared to give a detailed description of the incident and suspects.

Tips For Personal Safety

- 1) Lock your house doors, windows, and gates. Close garage doors. Use your alarm.
- 2) Light your home's exterior at night. Use interior light timers, especially when out of town.
- 3) Have a neighbor pick up mail, newspaper and trash cans when you are on vacation.
- 4) Make sure your house numbers are legible- imperative for emergencies.
- 5) Be aware that most burglaries happen during the day.
- 6) Make sure your house looks the same 365 days of the year!
- 7) Lock car doors, don't leave items visible (best in trunk or house). If possible put car in garage.
- 8) Protect yourself from Identity Theft. Do not give out personal info to phone or email solicitors.
- 9) Do not put social security number in wallet or car.
- 10) Purchase a shredder & shred, shred, shred.
