PLEASE NOTE: not all levels are offered during all time slots. Class ratios of instructors to participants are between 1:3 & 1:6; advanced classes may have more students.

SWIM LEVEL PASSING REQUIREMENTS:

Parent/Tot: Children from ages 6 months up to 3 years, accompanied by a parent.

Parents will get in the water to help their child learn water adjustments, support float, kicks, and assisted entries through instruction and games.

Starfish: Ages 3+. Enter and exit the water safely, demonstrate proper back float position, fully submerge unassisted.

Seahorse: Exit pool using bobs, front & back float for 5 seconds, 10 seconds of breath holding.

Guppy: Front and back float for 10 seconds, back float then turn to swim back to stairs or wall, swim 5 yards unassisted using a kickboard.

Goldfish: Streamline push-off wall and hold for 10 seconds, back float 15 seconds, kickboard assisted front and back kick 15 yards, 10 yards unassisted freestyle.

Seal: Back float 20 seconds, 25 yards assisted free style with side breathing, 25 yards assisted back stroke, tread water for 15 seconds.

Stingray: 25 yards free style with side breathing, 15 yards back stroke, 25 yards assisted breast stroke kick.

Dolphin: 50 yards free style, 25 yards back stroke, 15 yards breast stroke, dive, flip turn.

Shark: 100 yard free style, 50 yard back stroke, 25 yard breast stroke, butterfly, starts and turns.
