

Benevento Family Park Planning History City Council June 25, 2024





• Timeline

- May 26, 2020, City Council approved \$3,000,000 in impact fees to be used for design, engineering and construction of Benevento
 - Staff directed to discuss options for completing Benevento with the Parks and Recreation Commission to determine if funding appropriated for design and construction was the best use
- June 24, 2020 at the Parks and Recreation Commission meeting, the Commission formed the Benevento Ad-Hoc Subcommittee
- August 25, 2020, design contract approval with Wilson Design Studio Landscape Architecture (WDSLA) for the planning and design of Benevento Family Park (and Prospector Park)
- May 25, 2021, Benevento Ad-Hoc Subcommittee met to review preliminary concept ideas and updated ROM
- **July 19, 2021**, Benevento Ad-Hoc Subcommittee met to review the Needs Assessment and its influence on moving forward with Benevento



- Timeline (continued)
 - **September 22, 2021**, the Parks & Recreation Commission forwarded a recommendation to the City Council to continue with the design, engineering, and phased construction of Benevento Family Park
 - October 12, 2021, the City Council approved the Park & Recreation Commission's Recommendation with respect to design, engineering and phased construction of Benevento Family
 - May 24, 2022, the City Council approved an additional \$2,400,000 toward Benevento Family Park
 - August 1, 2022, Planning and Development Subcommittee met to review Master Plan and Phase I
 - August 2, 2022, the Parks & Recreation Commission forwarded a recommendation to the City Council to approve the Master Plan and Phase I
 - May 23, 2023, the City Council approved an additional \$923,288
 - June 21, 2024, the Parks & Recreation Commission Planning & Development Subcommittee met to discuss additional funding and approved the request for additional funding in FY 2024-25



- Our goal for **Phase I of Benevento** would be to include the following, in rough priority:
 - Volleyball Complex
 - Plaza area for the Volleyball Complex, including restroom/storage building (for sand groomer and VB equipment), paving and picnic tables
 - Lower parking lot adjacent to the Volleyball complex (82 stalls)
 - Stairs/ADA Ramps to access each of three levels of the park
 - Play area (Size of the play area will depend on available funding)
 - Upper parking lot (37 stalls)
 - Maintenance vehicle access path to access middle terrace
- The final determination of what is included in Phase I of Benevento will be based on the approved budget and updated cost estimates.





Plan Preferred by the Community and approved by the Parks & Recreation Commission



- Funding and Phasing
 - FY 2020-21, City Council approved \$3,000,000
 - FY 2022-23, City Council approved an additional \$2,400,000
 - FY 2023-24, City Council approved an additional \$923,288
 - Total allocation for Phase I is currently \$6,323,288
 - FY 2024-25 request for additional \$1,650,000
 - FY 2024-25 Budget for Phase I is \$7,973,288
