 a. Presentation of Preliminary Collision Data Analysis Findings for City's Local Road Safety Plan (LRSP) Update

Three Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc. consultants made a presentation. Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc. has been contracted to perform the LSRP. There will be social media posts and

a survey that will allow for public input. The Draft of the LRSP will be a future agenda item for the Traffic Safety Committee.

b. Review of Temporary Circulation Changes at Folsom High School

6. <u>INFORMATIONAL ITEMS</u>

a. Riley Street & Scott Street Intersection

Bosch provided an update regarding the intersection and corridor. The bike lane in that area was discussed. Possible options to encourage pedestrians to use the crosswalk and not cross in the middle of the road were discussed.

b. Traffic Safety Committee Action Item Updates

Bosch explained that some of the rectangular rapid flashing beacons arrived damaged and had to be sent back, and they are working to procure them so they can make the planned improvements.

Brausch reported that the bollard at Golf Links Road and Woodglen Drive needs to be repaired because it was hit. Additionally, the two bollards on Prewett Drive need to be repaired. She also asked for an update on the proposed Creekside Development project. She asked regarding Hummingbird Circle, and Bosch reported that a petition was never received from the neighborhood following the Traffic Safety Committee Meeting. She asked for an update regarding Willow Creek and Flower Drive improvements.

Bailey asked for an update on the sharp turn on Santa Juanita Road, and Bosch provided it.

Item 5b, the circulation changes at Folsom High School, will be a future agenda item.
