
Location Lot A Lot Map

Condition: Discolored Bark throughout crown and trunkline. Dead branches throughout crown currently approximately 75% declining 25% live. Large amounts of leaf drop early and discolored. Underground feeder roots cut during grading approximately 3 to 4 years ago before Astroturf installation. Astroturf gridding dripline and root system/feeder roots that remain/anchor roots adding to decline lack of nutrients and water intake found to be small addition to issue main feeder roots removed during grading main issue leading to lack of regeneration of crown and root system. Did neighborhood comparison to similar Quercus douglassi foliage and condition found decline and failure imminent within 12 months. Previous work done 6 to 7 years ago excessive, large cuts to leader supporting crown leaning toward house. Lean approximately 22 degrees to house. 80% crown leaning to and over house.

Recommendation: Removal and stump grind. Underground root system and bark discoloration and Cambium damage incapable of substantial regeneration of foliage and root system. Recommend not replanting in area 3 years minimum.
