## SUBJECT: Conditions of Approval: Tree Removal Permit #TREE24-10685

The City of Folsom Community Development Department (CDD) has reviewed an application for Tree Removal at **140 Egloff Street**. The following trees are included in the scope of the application:

The CDD has made the decision to conditionally approve the application based on the following findings:

- The proposal is in conformance with the provisions of FMC 12.16.080(B)(1) The condition of the protected tree with respect to disease, danger of falling, or long-term health of the tree is such that the tree is not likely to survive.
- The proposal is in conformance with the provisions of FMC 12.16.080(B)(5) The tree is a protected tree, other than a native oak tree or landmark tree, in the front yard of a residential property of one-half acre or less with an existing residential structure on site, and the property owner agrees to plant a replacement tree on the property consistent with the requirements of Section 12.16.150(A)(1)(c). (Ord. 1299 § 2 (part), 2020)

The following condition(s) have been assigned to this permit:

- 1. The applicant shall mitigate for the tree removals in accordance with Folsom Municipal Code 12.16.150(B)(2) Payment of In-Lieu Fee. Payment of in-lieu fees may be allowed where the subject property is not able to accommodate the required number of replacement trees on site. The in-lieu fee shall be calculated as a dollar amount for each DSH inch of protected tree removed, as adopted by city council resolution.
- 2. The applicant shall plant a minimum of 1 replacement street tree within 60 days from the issuance of the tree permit. The replacement trees shall be from a minimum 15-gallon container, located within 12.5' from the back of the sidewalk, and shall be an approved species on the Folsom Master Tree List.
- 3. The permittee shall defend, protect, indemnify, and hold harmless the City of Folsom and its officials, agents, and employees from any and all claims, demands, suits, causes of action, damages, costs, expenses, losses, or liability, in law or in equity, of every kind and nature

whatsoever arising out of or in connection with the issuance of the Tree Permit or the permittee's work performed under the Tree Permit.

The decision on this application is subject to a 10-calendar day appeal period which commences **09-27-2024** and extends through **10-07-2024**. Any party dissatisfied with the determination on this application may file an appeal to the CDD Director. Once issued, the tree removal permit is non-transferable.
