Option Two - Self-Haul Acknowledgement Form

Under *Part A(2)*, specify the names of the facilities where your waste materials will be delivered.

Part B. After Project Completion: Write in the total weights or volume for all recycled, salvaged (re-used) or landfilled materials generated from your project-site.

You must provide copies of weight tickets or receipts with the following information: 1) Facility name, 2) load weight or volume of materials delivered to the facility. ****Commercial projects (non-residential) based on 1) alteration projects with valuations of less than \$200,000, as determined by City's Building Division, and 2) commercial additions less than 1,000 square feet, are exempt from WMP requirements and fees.***

C. Diversion Compliance Fees - \$20/ton
(Fees for not meeting 65% diversion requirement)

A person can typically meet the 65% diversion requirement by recycling or reusing all of the wood, metal, sheet rock, dirt, rocks, concrete and cardboard. These materials typically make up 50% - 75% of all debris generated from a project. Please see the Contractor's Resource Guide for more details.
