



REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF A BUILDING PERMIT CD-B107

Sections 105.3.2 and 105.5 of the California Building Code state that the Chief Building Official may extend the time for action on a building permit for a period not exceeding 180 calendar days or an application for 90 calendar days if requested before the permit or application has expired. The applicant must show that circumstances beyond the control of the applicant prevented action from being taken. No application or permit shall be extended more than once. In order to renew action on a building permit after expiration, the applicant may be required to submit new plans and pay new fees. *Per State AB2913, permits expire 12 months after issuance if there have been no approved required inspections during that time period OR 180 calendar days after the last approved required inspection. **Applications** shall be considered abandoned 9 months after the date of filing, unless pursued in good faith or a permit is issued. Per FMC Section 14.02.050 all building permits shall be valid for up to two years after issuance date so long as the requirements above are compiled with.*
