**Subject:** District Gerrymandering Concerns by Citizens

While reading the multiple comments posted on the DNR website, it is disheartening to see citizens' concerns about gerrymandering have not been addressed. In keeping with transparency, I am asking City Council, the City Attorney, the City demographer, and the City Manager to post which proposed district each current council member presently resides. I am also asking the City Council, the City Attorney, the City demographer, and the City Manager to make known the proposed districts each current council member will knowingly reside in on November 8, 2022.

In addition to gerrymandering, concerns were raised by citizens speaking via the phone on Zoom at one of the earlier Council meetings about Councilman Kozlowski building a house in one of the districts he has input. Since Councilman Kozlowski is one of five drawing (and voting) on district boundaries, it would be right and fair to make this information known to the public to avoid any appearance of gerrymandering by Council and address citizens' concerns.

I ask the above be done before Council votes on the final district map on 2/22.
